

This notepad definitely came in handy for me (ran almost out of paper)! I'm an indigent inmate, so anything that can be used shall be used wisely. My guarantee is that the Majority of inmates in this phison are grateful for your generosity. Currently, I reside in the Réception Center in Badgér section. We have been on a COVID-19/ Modified Lockdown since March 14,2020. Masks have been issued to us and are to be worn whenever we leave our cell (except showers). Food trays and lunches are brought from the cafeteria to our unit, From the first tier to the fourth tier (no one resides on the fifth tier), we-

are let out and grab our food, then head back to eat in our cells. There is still yard time once to twice a week and supplies are being issued each week. I arrived here to Reception on March 09, 2020. Many innates are endorsed to Mainline prisons as of now, including myself. A few complications still hold us from getting Milestone Completion Credits, reduced sentence time, quarterly packages, etc. the longer we are stuck in Reception, the more we are defrived of and continue to feel dismayed. Plenty of 22 Forms & GO2 Forms have been filed throughout the past weeks. Mainly in concern of living conditions & unobtainable privilidges. From my perspective, innates in this unit are dealing with this epidemic as best as they can, as well as staff.
