Hello to you, how are you doing, considering the circumstances? I trust that all is well with you and your organization because y'all giving out free treats and stuff. Therefor, I guessing that you kept some for yourself, just in case things get tight out there? =) You should know that the package was well received and I'd like to THANK YOU ALL for it, personally. It was unexpected, had some snacks in it, and there was some much needed soap. So, good job...

I'm not too sure that you all will be working towards getting myself or any of the other DEATH ROW PRISONERS out during this time. However, I, ALEXANDER RASHAD HAMILTON, have been incarcerated for (15) total and (22½) of the last have been spent as a Condemned Prisoner. And, my behavior has been pretty good. So, if you were to advocate for any of our releases, you might want to place my name at the front of the list, you know. Just thought that UI would throw that out there if you were thinking what I was thinking...

The yard program has been reduced from everyday privileges, to only (3) times a week with only one side of the unit. East Block consist of "BAY SIDE & YARD SIDE." So, whoever is on the same side goes outside together and you never see anyone on the other side now. There's no visiting of any kind, whether legal or regular. We've been given wasks that we must wear outside and while we're outside. They actually passed out (2) different ones. They're extremely snug on the face and make it hard to breathe just having it on. We're also forced to wear them while we exercise, outside. Which doesn't make any sense because that's not even the law outside of this place. So, I think that prison officials need to be reminded of this fact here, sooner than later...

It'd be a great help if we had more soap around here. bar soap, specifically, but any kind would help with the religious washing process that one must keep up. family and friends have been out of work so those that were helping us out are no longer in such a position to do such...

Anotherthing that would be a great help to us all, especially myself, is if you could connect Me with someone to correspond with. Some written companionship would be great right about now. This is something that's always welcomed but even more so, now. And, YES, I do speak for all of us behind these walls with this statement here...

I'll end this here but before I go, please know that I don't have any problem with you sharing this letter with anyone, on any site. It's okay to share this letter through e-mail or whatever. If you have any questions for me as swell, you know where to find me... THANK YOU for your time. I'll hear from you if and when I do...=)
