

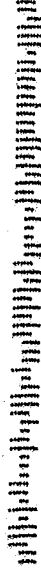

My Name is Kenneth Jenkins I'm 60^{yr} old and
I'm a inmate at San Quentin Reception
Center, and I would like to thank you for
the nice gift that was given to me.
It was a much needed gift and I
appreciate you for thinking about me
and all of the other inmates. I'm sure
if you don't get a respond from other
inmates I can assure you that they
are thankful and appreciate their gift
also.

I'm respond to your letter and would like
to address some issues that I am
having here in the Reception Center.
I want to elaborate on a few things you
wrote about in your letter, because I would
love for the Prison University Project
to advocate for me. I noticed you wrote
about advocating for people with health issues.
I myself have health issues that I feel
was over looked when the prison was given
early release due to COVID-19.

I Am a inmate with Chronic Heart disease who has to carry Nitroglycerin on my person 24 hours a day. I have Bone marrow, and I Am in a Enhanced outpatient program, I Agnos with PTSD all of my Health issues put me at High Risk To Covid-19.

I Am a Non Violent inmate who doesn't have any violence on my record, I'm currently waiting to go to the mainline here at San Quentin. I only have a couple more months, my release date is 7/15/20 and because of this extended stay here in the reception Covid-19 is preventing me from transferring to the mainline, and because of not being able to transfer I'm unable to get my Good Conduct Credits. My Good Conduct Credit will allow me to receive my 2 for 1 and with the short time that I have left it will put me out of prison before my earliest parole release date. It is written in the Title 15 that Enhanced outpatient program, inmate who are in that program that has been in the reception center for 61

days or longer are to be awarded
Group M, and awarded their Good
Conduct Credit. I've been in Reception
for 70 something days and I would very
much like to have someone
advocate for me so that I can get what
I'm supposed to get. It's only fair that
I receive my Good Conduct Credit so
that I can go home before my original
release date. Thank you very much for
taking the time out and reading my letter
feel free to share it with others.
