My name is, Fabian Rosales-Reyes, an inmate in, San Quentin Reception Center. I'm writing you today let you and the community know how things are going inside (Badger) reception center.

As we all knew, San Quentin, was "Covid-19" virus free. Well it was up until May 30, 2020, when a bus from "Chino State Prison" got sent to San Quentin.

Now, "Chino State Prison", has had Covid-19 cases and both San Quentin and Sacramento knew about it.

So now in less than "Two" weeks San Quentin Reception Center, "Badger", has come up with, "15" cases of Covid-19. Yes the, 5th and 4th, tires in ~~Badger~~ Badger are now "Main Lines", but still they shouldn't have house them with reception and now because they did someone in the, 2nd tire, which the 3rd, 2nd, & 1st tires are reception, got Covid-19.

Both Sacramento and San Quentin has put all receptions lives in great danger with this virus that is known to kill people. They are not doing even close to a great job to keep us safe. Our living cells are as old as to the 1950's and we have to clean our cells with a shirt or towel, because we don't get any cleaning stuff. Our shower's are "8" shower heads for ~~25~~ 25 cells, which has two people each at times. There is no way to social distancing.

Almost every inmate here in San Quentin has kids, wife, and family to go back to, and are trying to get back too. I think the Governor should let go home all inmates within 3 years left and that are "Nonviolent Offenders".

Well thank you for allowing me to send this letter and for taking the time in reading it.
